Dear Valued Customer;

We are in receipt of your request, for a signed certification stating that none of the materials we supply to you, include ingredients listed as probable or known carcinogens as per the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986.

While our products do not intentionally incorporate any listed carcinogenic materials as per this regulation, it is possible that small traces of such materials may remain on the material as a normal part of the production process. For this reason, we cannot categorically state that our products do not contain any Proposition 65 listed substances.

Of note, our processes include thorough washing of the final product before shipment, which may well result in any residual material being below the Proposition 65 Maximum Allowable Dose Level for any potential exposure to our products.

Nonetheless, we suggest that your firm research the requirements associated with use and production of materials and items, to determine what, if any, steps should be taken to ensure compliance with the stated regulation.
