Subject: RoHS 3 Restricted Substances Compliance Statement  
EU Directive 2015/863 Category 11 additions

The European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances (“RoHS”) directives specify maximum levels of 10 restricted substances, that may be present in electronic materials and certain medical devices.

Combined Metals Company LLC (“CMC”) is happy to state that none of the original six restricted substances, nor any of the 4 Phthalate substances recently added are contained above the stated threshold levels in the alloys that CMC processes.

The complete list of RoHS regulated substances, and respective concentrations, are:

- Cadmium (0.01 %)
- Lead (0.1 %)
- Mercury (0.1 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Note that the currently proposed RoHS Pack 15 may bring additional materials into the RoHS list of Restricted Substances. While no percent thresholds have yet been established, CMC products do not generally contain any of the proposed materials at or above 0.1% concentration. As these additions to the RoHS list have not yet been approved, no compliance thresholds or obligations have yet been established.
